ACTS OF COUNCIL

Ms Pierce made a motion that the Acts of Council for the May meeting be approved as written.

Ms Arnold presented the monthly report.

PINE MOUNTAIN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

- a) Community Pride Day-General clean-up day will be Saturday (June 14th) from 8:30-11:00
- b) Basketball Goals-Mrs Epstein advised the Mayor and Council that the Chamber would like to see the goals put up.
- c) Pine Mountain Sign (Reader)-The Chamber would like to place a reader sign at the ball park on Highway 27 to advise tourists of the upcoming events in Pine Mountain.
- d) Motorcoach Parking-Mrs Epstein requested a designated area for Motorcoach parking. Mayor Teel suggested in front of IGA, however, we would need to contact the Railroad to get approval.
- e) Christmas Decorations-Chamber would like to add to the Christmas decorations, however, they would need an area to store them. Mayor Teel advised Mrs Epstein storage was no longer a problem at the present police department. However, when we proceed with the new public safety center the old building will be torn down.

BEER & WINE LICENSE (ROSE COTTAGE)(BRUCE THOMPSON)-1st READING

Mayor Teel presented the 1st reading for beer and wine license for Rose Cottage in the name of Bruce Thompson.
