ACTS OF COUNCIL

F/D DISPATCH Re: STORM DEBRIS

1) Mr Kober announced that the Pine Mountain Fire Department has been awarded a grant for approximately \$8,000.00. The Department will be providing smoke detectors and fire extinguishers for each home within the Town limits.

2) Mr Kober announced that the FEMA application grant window is open until the end of April.

3) Mr Kober discussed the letter to the editor that was written in the Harris County Journal by Harris County Sheriff (Mike Jolley) and 911 Director (Monty Davis) on March 3, 2005.

In the letter they stated that "E911 and the county have been notified that many of the volunteer fire departments are no longer available to help with road clearing and debris clearing during times of extreme weather conditions.

Mr Kober stated, that the Pine Mountain Fire Department has never refused to answer a call. In the last 6 or 7 months the F/D has 70 man hours in clearing debris.
Mayor Teel thanked the Fire Department for the job they do. He stated that the Pine Mountain Fire Department is the best in the county if not the state.

Mr Kober, Mr Chason and Ms Pierce voted in favor of the motion.

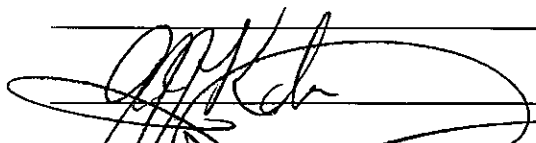


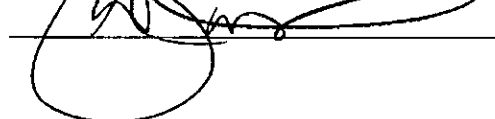
