Ms Laura Burns requested the parking spaces on Chipley be slant instead of parallel parking.

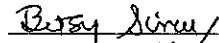
Mayor Teel advised Ms Burns that he would have Brent Bullington check into the matter to see if it would be wide enough.

ADJOURNMENT

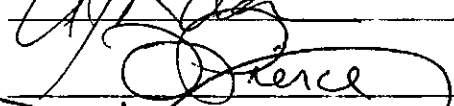
Ms Pierce made a motion that the meeting be adjourned.

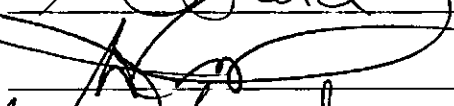
Ms Ewell seconded the motion.
