PINE MOUNTAIN POLICE DEPARTMENT UPDATE-Major Bramell

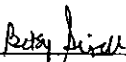
The Police Department has applied for and been approved for a Bullet Proof Vest Grant. There are no funds required of the Town.

Major Bramell requested permission to apply for a grant from Naval Surface Warfare, this grant would be used for the K-9 officer tracking at night and suspicious actives. The department is requesting 2 goggles for the K-9 officer and 2 hand held units. Each unit is \$300.00 which is a total of \$1,200.00 per year. The Department of the Navy is responsible for the upkeep.

Mr Teasley made a motion to approve the request to apply for the grant.
Mr Kober seconded the motion.
Ms Ewell, Ms Pierce and Mr Trott voted in favor of the motion.

The police department is working on a grant/s for a project called "Safe Cycling" this would enable the department to receive a traffic radar sled, lidar, free bike helmets, materials and literature from the GOHS. The grants are through State Farm and WalMart.

Mr Teasley seconded the motion.
Ms Ewell, Ms Pierce and Mr Trott voted in favor of the motion.

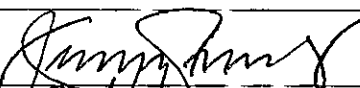
Thereafter, the meeting was adjourned.



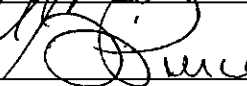
