ACTS OF COUNCIL

Mr Teasley made a motion to approve the Acts of Council for the August meeting as written.

Mr Kober seconded the motion.

Mr Trott, Ms Pierce and Ms Ewell voted in favor of the motion.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mayor Teel presented the financial report for August.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM

Ms Arnold reminded everyone of the Street Festival for the "Bike MS Cox Atlanta Ride 2008" that will be held on September 12, 2008.

Ms Arnold reminded everyone that Commerce Avenue and McDougald Avenue (see attached map for the location) would need to be blocked off on Thursday night. The remaining area(s) would need to be blocked off on Friday morning.

Ms Arnold requested the use of the gym on Friday night for the vendors in case of rain.

Ms Arnold also requested the use of Town Hall for Cricket's Restaurant and to place tables and chairs for the riders to have dinner.

Mr Kober made a motion to use the area(s) for one time as long as it's cleaned up afterward.

BASKETBALL MINISTRY-SHANNAH MABRY AND RACHEL BURCH

Ms Mabry and Ms Burch requested permission to use the Gym two (2) Saturdays out of the month, for a new program they would like to start (a basketball ministry called "Christ's Court Basketball" for the youth in the community).

The program would be free for those participating in the community. This is not a church event, only sponsored by the church.

Mayor Teel explained to the ladies that it can not interfere with Coach Fox's program, if it does they will not be able to use the gym. The ladies stated they had talked with Coach Fox and he was okay with the program. The ladies also stated in no way would they interfere with what he does.

Mr Kober made a motion to allow the use of the gym with the following rules:

- 1) Must have proof of insurance given to Town Clerk.
- 2) Must clean up afterwards
- 3) DO NOT block the public safety facility driveway(s)

Mayor Teel explained that if any problems took place the Town could take away the motion granted.

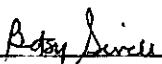

PUBLIC SAFETY DAY (September 20th)-Major Bramell

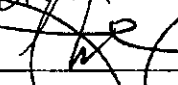
Major Bramell reminded everyone of the Public Safety Day Event which will be held on Saturday, September 20th.

Major Bramell requested that the outlets be checked before the event.

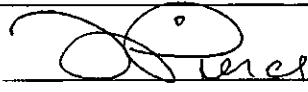
Thereafter, the meeting was adjourned.
