The Mayor and Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in a regular session on the evening of Monday, December 14, 2009 at 7:00 P.M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor Joe D Teel, Jr presided with Councilpersons Jerry M Teasley, Tamara M Pierce, James W Trott and Andrew J Kober in attendance. Barbara Bell Ewell was not in attendance.

ACTS OF COUNCIL

Mr Kober made a motion to approve the Acts of Council as written for the November meeting.

Mr Trott seconded the motion.

Ms Pierce and Mr Teasley voted in favor of the motion.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mayor Teel presented the financial report for November.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM

Ms Arnold thanked the Mayor and Council members for helping with the purchase of the new Christmas tree for downtown. She also, thanked Brent Bullington and his staff for putting up and securing the tree and creating the star on top.
