Mr Teasley seconded the motion also under protest.

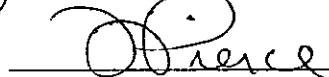
Ms Ewell, Ms Pierce and Mr Kober voted in favor of the motion.

ADJOURNMENT

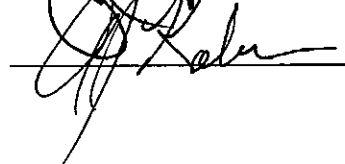
Thereafter, the meeting was adjourned.
