BUILDING IN FRONT OF BETHANY BAPTIST FOR SPORTS EQUIPMENT STORAGE-ROBERT MCGHEE

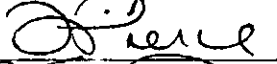
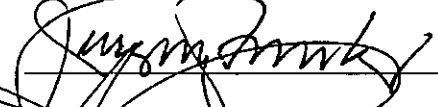
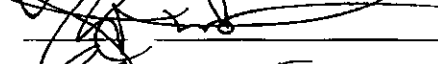
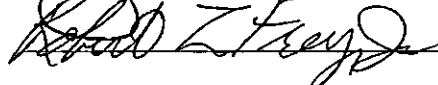
Mr McGhee came before the Mayor and Council requesting the old building in front of Bethany Baptist Church for Sports Equipment Storage.
