PMFD PROJECT LIFESAVER GRANT AND AFG GRANT-Andy Kober

Project Lifesaver Grant-is a radio telemetry system that is utilized to find missing elderly persons suffering from Alzheimer's Disease. It is also used to locate autistic children.

AFG GRANT-The Fire Department would like to apply for a mini-pumper and equipment to include turnout gear. If the grant is successful a five percent match is required, however, the Fire Department has the funds.
