RESOLUTION HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN-Monty Davis (EMA Director)

This plan is Federal Mandated by Homeland Security. State and Local governments are required to develop, submit and obtain FEMA approval of a hazard mitigation plan. Completion of an HMP that meets the Federal requirements will increase access to funds for local governments and

allow them to remain eligible. If you have a disaster and you do not adopt the plan you will get no money.

Mayor Teel asked Mr Davis why was the Pine Mountain Animal Park is included in the plan when it is not in Pine Mountain, nor is it Harris County.

Mr Davis stated that it has been omitted from the plan.

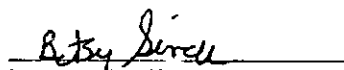
Mr Trott made a motion to approve the resolution with the understanding the Pine Mountain Animal Park be taken out.

Ms Pierce and Mr Frey voted in favor of the motion.

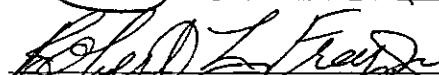

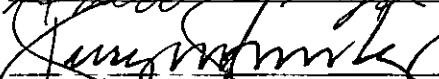
Thereafter, the meeting was adjourned.

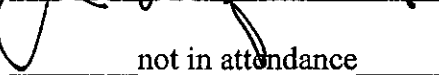
