ACTS OF COUNCIL

Mr Frey made a motion to approve the Acts of Council as written for the May meeting(s).

Ms Ewell seconded the motion.

Mr Teasley and Ms Pierce voted in favor of the motion.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mayor Teel presented the financial report for May.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM

Ms Arnold presented the Mayor and Council with a draft of the contract for F/Y 2010/2011.

**CARRIAGE AND HORSES dba ROTISSERIE BELLA-BEER & WINE LICENSE
(ABLA DAGHER)-2nd READING**

Mayor Teel presented the first reading for the amendment to the beer and wine ordinance.

THEFT BY SHOPLIFTING (LOCAL ORDINANCE)-1st READING

Mayor Teel presented the first reading for Theft by Shoplifting (Local Ordinance).

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (SAVE PROGRAM)

Mayor Teel presented the memorandum of agreement for the SAVE Program between the Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services, and the Town of Pine Mountain, Georgia.

The purpose of this MOA is to establish the terms and conditions governing the participation of the User Agency to provide the specified benefit in the DHS-USCIS Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program for the purpose of verifying citizenship and immigration status information of non-citizen and naturalized or derived U.S. citizen applicants applying for Retirement Benefits, Health Benefits, Contracts, Alcoholic Beverage Licenses, Occupation Tax Certificates and Insurance Company Licenses.

Ms Pierce made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Agreement for the SAVE Program.

Mr Frey seconded the motion.

Ms Ewell and Mr Teasley voted in favor of the motion.

SPEED BUMPS IN RESIDENTIAL NEIGHBORHOOD (MEADOWSPRINGS DRIVE)-Cindy Williamson

Ms Williamson shared with the Mayor and Council concerns of the safety for the children and elderly people walking on Meadowsprings Drive due to speeding in the area. Ms Williamson stated that Children Playing Signs and Speed Limit Signs have been placed, however, speeding is still an issue.

Ms Ewell explained that a petition from the neighborhood would have to be received in order to place speed bumps because some folks complain when we put them up.

Chief Bramell explained to Ms Williamson that he would contact the construction foreman to get them to have his people watch their speed.

ALLEY BEHIND ROTISSERIE BELLA-James Chambers

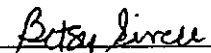

According to the tax records dated back to November 1943 the alley between the property belongs to Mr Chambers.

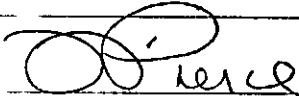
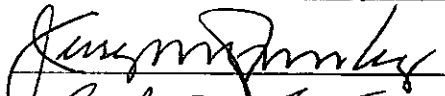
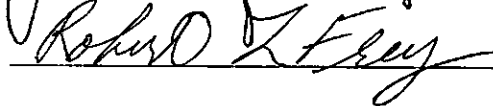
Mayor Teel explained to Mr Chambers if the Town does not have ownership the Council can not give permission.
