Mayor Teel explained to Mrs Johnson that Town property could not be used to make a profit, however, Mrs Johnson stated that they would not be making a profit.

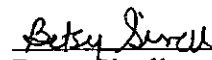
No action was taken on this matter.

IMPACT 360 (GROWTH)-Eric Turner

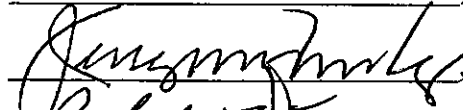
Mr Turner gave an update to the Mayor and Town Council on the anticipated growth of IMPACT 360. They are planning to expand to 35 students for the coming year.

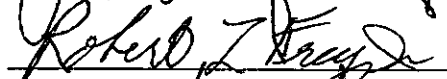

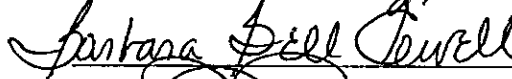
Thereafter, the meeting was adjourned.

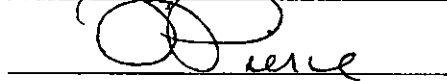
