The Mayor and Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in a regular session on the evening of Monday, November 8, 2010 at 7:00 P.M. in Town Hall.

ACTS OF COUNCIL

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM

Ms Arnold announced the following events:

GEORGIA POWER FRANCHISE AGREEMENT-Mayor Teel

The Georgia Power Franchise Agreement would allow the Town of Pine Mountain to receive 4% of the gross sales of electric energy to customers served under residential and commercial rate schedules within the corporate limits of the Town. This Agreement would be extended until October 8, 2030.
