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Earth-Scapes, Inc.	194,521.00
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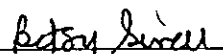
Southeastern Site Development	289,958.25

Ms. Pierce seconded the motion.

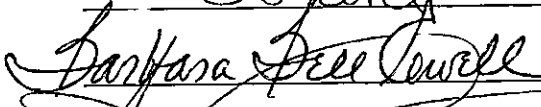
Mr. Trott and Ms. Ewell voted in favor of the motion.

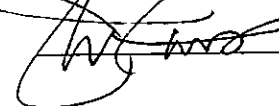
Thereafter, the meeting was adjourned.
