Ms. Hall was not in attendance.

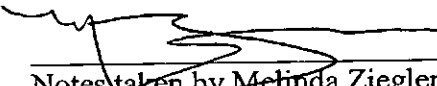
LOCAL HOMESTEAD TAX RELIEF-Mayor Teel

Mr. Trott made a motion to NOT give the Local Homestead Tax Relief this year.

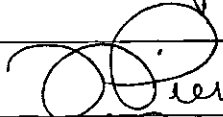
Mr. Frey seconded the motion.
