Ms. Mullins seconded the motion.

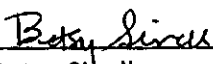
Mr. Aldrich, Ms. Pierce and Mrs. Bray voted in favor of the motion.

ADJOURNMENT

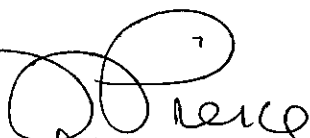
Ms. Mullins made a motion the meeting be adjourned.

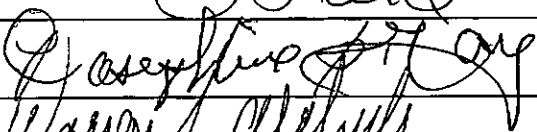
Mrs. Bray seconded the motion.

Mr. Pendergrass, Mr. Aldrich and Ms. Pierce voted in favor of the motion.

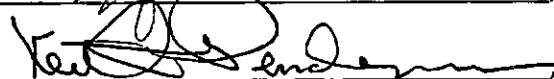
