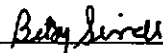

Mrs. Bray made a motion that the meeting be adjourned.

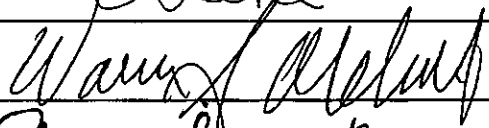
Ms. Mullins seconded the motion.

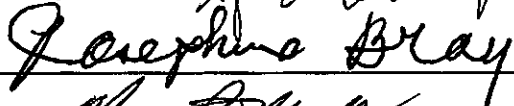
