SHOVEL READY PLAN

The lines that are being discussed to be replaced are as follows:

Near First Peoples Bank

Near Askew Park

Mayor Mullins stated that we would need to have Precision Planning work on a plan and the grant and ask that we place that on the May council agenda.

RELEAF TREE GRANT

Mayor Mullins discussed a grant that is available called "ReLeaf Tree Grant". The grant is in the amount of \$15,000.00. You can buy a tree and plant it or give away a tree. This would only apply to the part of Meriwether County that is in the Town, which would be Springdale.

Mayor Mullins requested this be placed on the May agenda to apply for the grant.

TREE ORDINANCE

A fee can be paid for those not wanting to replant a tree.
